This office has recently completed an audit of Stage & Picture Operators AFL-CIO, LU 728 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you, CPA Michael J. Borenstein, Vice President Pascal M. Guillemard, and Business Representative Patric J.
