Gentlemen:

This office has recently completed an audit of ILA Local 920 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959, as Amended (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you, the following reporting errors were discovered during the CAP. The matter listed below is not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

The CAP disclosed the following:

LM-2 filing for year ended December 31, 2003 was deficient as the amount of dues money refunded to members - \$163,546 - was netted against dues money actually received by Local 920.

Those numbers need to be reported in aggregate on Form LM-2.

amended LM-2 needs to be completed to reflect the above changes. Kindly forward the signed, amended LM-2 to me no later than April 24, 2005.
