Dear Mr. Long:

This office has recently completed an audit of the Electrical Workers Local 1613 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP), to determine your organization's compliance with provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959, (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with Greg Goin on Thursday, July 21, 2005, at 9:00 a.m., the following problems were disclosed during the CAP. The matters listed below are not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

The audit revealed a violation of LMRDA Section 502 (Bonding), which requires that the union's officers and employees be bonded for no less than ten percent of the total funds handled by those individuals or their predecessor during the preceding fiscal year. Local 1613's officers and employees are currently bonded for \$30,000, but they must be bonded for at least \$32,762. The union should obtain adequate bonding coverage for its officers and employees immediately. Please provide proof of bonding coverage to this office as soon as adequate coverage has been obtained.
